Driven by curiosity to explore the world around us, I find joy in embarking on watercolor adventures. A trusty travel notebook is always at my side, capturing my life's moments through sketches. It's a practice that requires you to get to the heart of the matter by sketching on the spot. But also a certain letting go by accepting the unforeseen and random side of watercolor. Personally, it's an absolute delight!

For this kit, I've selected tools adapted to the world of urban sketching. Thanks to the MONO bag, you'll be able to take the products anywhere and be ready to sketch every moment! Here's a step-by-step guide to create a Mediterranean landscape. On the last page, you'll also find a link to two detailed videos for creating this landscape, as well as a Mediterranean allev.

STEP 1 - SKETCH

The initial step is to prepare your drawing by sketching the landscape with the MONO 100 pencil. You can refine this sketch with the MONO mini eraser, providing a perfect base for your coastal landscape sketch. Preferably use watercolor paper for optimum rendering and to avoid damaging the paper during coloring.



STEP 2 - COLORING

Add your first touches of color.

Use the sea-blue Tombow ABT Dual Brush Pen 373, to sketch the contours of the water. Then use the Water Brush to play with shades, gradually evolving towards the desired final result.

Let your creativity flow: you can choose to apply the ABT Dual Brush Pen directly to the watercolor paper, then create the watercolor effect with the Water Brush, or deposit the color on a palette and transfer it with the Water Brush.

Don't hesitate to intensify colors by adding complementary colors. You can return to your drawing several times.





Use the same techniques to bring the landscape to life with the Tombow ABT Dual Brush Pen 565 and the field to life with the Tombow ABT Dual Brush Pen 026.

Once you're happy with your result, use the fine tip of the ABT Dual Brush Pen to add the fine, delicate details to your artwork. To complete the artwork, erase pencil lines with the MONO eraser, whose soft plastic texture guarantees impeccable results.





Continue your sketch by watercoloring branches and leaves with the ABT Dual Brush Pen 177, creating visual harmony on your sketch. Be sure to clean your Water Brush between each color. Add shadows with ABT Dual Brush Pen N75.





STEP 3 - DETAILS

When you're satisfied with your watercolor work, let it dry. Once dry, it's time to add details (boats, birds...) using your MONO drawing pen. This fineliner will also enable you to add more intensity to the sketch.
